

Campus Sexual Assault Victim's Bill of Rights

This document outlines your rights according to the Pennsylvania *Sexual Violence Education at Institutions of Higher Education Act*, should you become a victim of sexual violence.

South Hills will assist you in notifying any outside individuals or agencies if you so choose.

- **YOU** have the right to notify the following individuals or agencies if you are a victim of sexual violence:
 1. Anonymously Contact South Hills
 2. Notify South Hills
 3. South Hills Assistance
 4. Notify Local/State Police
 5. Decline To Notify Law Enforcement
- **YOU** have the right to be notified of counseling services.
- **YOU** have the right to obtain an order of protection, no contact order, or restraining order issued by a criminal or civil court, or to enforce an order already in existence.
- **YOU** have the right to request that prompt disciplinary proceedings be initiated against the accused.
- **YOU** and the accused have the right to be notified of the outcome of any disciplinary actions against the accused.
- **YOU** and the accused have the right to have others present during disciplinary proceedings.
- **YOU** have the right to be notified of any options in changing your academic situation.
